Today we are going to do a short revision of the comparison of adjectives and some exercises. You should remember most of it from last year, but we can never be too sure. 😊

The basic things to remember are:

	Primernik	Presežnik
Pravilni pridevniki		
<i>enozložni</i>		
tall	taller	the tallest
<i>dvozložni na -y</i>		
easy	easier	the easiest
<i>dvozložni</i>		
helpful	more helpful	the most helpful
<i>večzložni</i>		
expensive	more expensive	the most expensive
Nepravilni pridevniki		
good	better	the best
bad	worse	the worst



Remember what the letter G at the bottom of the explanation means?

There's more in your workbooks. In this case, it's on page 109. Make SURE you read that as well.

Before you do the exercises, take a look at this video, just to further refresh your knowledge. First part of the video shows examples of comparative and superlative forms. At the 6.15 mark, the rules are also briefly explained.

Don't forget the exceptions to the rule:

good	better	the best
bad	worse	the worst
little	less	the least
much	more	the most
far	farther	the farthest

Remember, when you compare two things, make sure that you use the word "THAN" and not the word "THEN"!

example:

My dog is faster THAN your dog.
