FREQUENCY ADVERBS

1) Textbook, p. 58 – Exercise 1a

- Look at the pictures of the animals. Read the sentences.
- In your mind, match the sentences with the photos.
- Copy the sentences into your notebook and translate them into Slovenian. (Prepiši povedi iz učbenika v zvezek in jih prevedi.)

2) Watch [the video](#) and afterwards **underline the adverbs of frequency** in your sentences (i.e., Dolphins always live in groups.) (Po ogledu videa v zgornjih povedih podčrtaj prislove pogostosti.)

Adverbs of Frequency
An adverb of frequency tells us how often something takes place.

100%	ALWAYS	I <u>always</u> wake up at 6 o'clock
90%	USUALLY	I <u>usually</u> come home after work
80%	NORMALLY/ GENERALLY	I <u>normally</u> swim after school
70%	OFTEN/ FREQUENTLY	I <u>often</u> spend Christmas with friends
50%	SOMETIMES	I <u>sometimes</u> play tennis on the weekend
30%	OCCASIONALLY	I <u>occasionally</u> eat Vietnamese food
10%	SELDOM	I <u>seldom</u> go to the library
5%	RARELY	I <u>rarely</u> listen to the radio
0%	NEVER	I <u>never</u> listen to rock music

Now, do you now know what adverbs of frequency are?

We use frequency adverbs to say how often something happens.

(S prislovi pogostosti povemo, kako pogosto se kaj dogaja.)

100%	always (vedno)	I always do my homework.
	usually (ponavadi)	Dad usually fixes things at home.
	often (pogosto)	We often tell jokes.
	sometimes (včasih)	I sometimes forget to lock the front door.
	seldom (redko)	I seldom eat fish.
0%	rarely (redko)	Mum rarely makes pizza.
	never (nikoli)	My sister never sings in the shower.

Word order: (Kje v povedi stojijo prislovi?)

Frequency adverbs usually go **before the main verb**.

(Prislovi pogostosti ponavadi stojijo pred glagolom.)

BUT (#Pazi1)

Frequency adverbs go **after the verb to be**.

(Prislovi pogostosti stojijo **za glagolom biti** – *am, is, are*.)

I am always happy. Not: I always am happy.
Dad is usually good at fixing things.
We are often quite funny.
I am sometimes forgetful.
I am seldom here.
Mum is rarely free.
My sister is never late for school.

REMEMBER (#Pazi2)

Some adverbs of frequency usually go at the end of the sentence.

(Nekateri prislovi pogostosti običajno stojijo na zadnjem mestu v povedi.)
