Welcome to another English lesson. I hope you are well and ready to learn something new.

Let's begin.

On Monday you read about Kate Kelly, a student who plans a holiday in America. She was telling you about her itinerary (a plan for a trip/holiday- načrt poti). She used a structure: I'm going to spend, I'm going to work, I'm going to teach...next summer.

COPY into your notebook: (prepiši v zvezek)

the GOING - TO FUTURE tense (prihodnjik)

We use the Going – to Future tense for the actions that we plan (for the future) in advance and for the actions that we can foretell out of the circumstances.

(Going-to future strukturo uporabljamo za dejanja, ki jih načrtujemo vnaprej in za dejanja, ki jih lahko napovemo iz dane situacije/okolijščin.)

We form it with auxiliary verb **to BE** (am, is, are)+ **going to** + **verb**

(tvorimo ga s pomožnim glagolom BITI + going to + glagol)

eg. (*for the planned actions*):

I'm going to tell you a story.

You are going to study some English words.

He is going to copy today's lesson into his notebook.

(*for the actions that we foretell*):

Look at that woman's belly. She is going to have a baby.

Oh no, those dark clouds. It is going to rain soon.

OPEN your book on page 85 and **DO** exercise 3 into your notebook. (Odpri učbenik, stran 85 in v zvezek reši nalogo 3)

We are going to check your homework on Friday at our video meeting. I'm looking forward to seeing you again. (Nalogo bomo pregledali v petek na video srečanju. Se že veselim.)
